



## Silver Star Stays Helpful Information

### Winter

---

At Silver Star Mountain we are fortunate to have four distinct seasons:

**Winter:** Mid November - April is the Nordic and downhill ski season with everything open.

**Spring:** The first Monday of April till mid-June - shoulder season with very limited services available on the hill. Very peaceful.

**Summer:** Hiking and biking season. The third weekend in June is the kick off for biking season till after Labour Day (first Monday of September) the hill is in full swing, 7 days a week. Depending on the weather there is usually two bonus weekends in June and two bonus weekends in September to enjoy hiking and biking.

**Fall:** Mid-September till the middle of November - shoulder season with very limited services available on the hill. Great time to enjoy some quiet time and ideal for a family get together for the Canadian Thanksgiving weekend.

All our properties are privately owned and managed by Silver Star Stays. There are no staff on the premises and no front desk. It is **ESSENTIAL** that you take your check-in information with you, including driving instructions and the unit specific information sheet which includes the keyless entry code to the property you have rented. This allows you to access your unit any time after check-in time which is 4:00 p.m.

**Mountain Host:** Your resident mountain host lives at Silver Star year round. If you have any questions, comments or concerns please let us know via email ([info@silverstarstays.com](mailto:info@silverstarstays.com)) so that we can ensure that your holiday is everything you expected. Please do not wait until after you are home or letting us know for the first time in a negative review.

If you have any difficulties accessing your unit upon arrival or during your stay please call or text our 24 hour emergency line 250-241-7827. Please note if you require Silver Star Stays services due to a forgotten code or any other issue that is not Silver Star Stays' responsibility, you will be charged a minimum \$38.50 call-out fee.

**Basic Supplies:** Each rental unit is supplied with a starter supply of toilet paper and paper towels; this will not be restocked during your stay. If you run out of these items there is a great store in the village that sells everything you might need.

**Damages upon Check In:** Please advise us ([info@silverstarstays.com](mailto:info@silverstarstays.com)) immediately if anything is damaged, missing or broken at the time of check-in. You are responsible for the property during your stay.

**Pets:** Some of our properties are pet friendly and this is identified in the highlights of each property. An additional daily fee of \$30 plus tax per pet is charged. If pets are brought in to non-pet friendly units a minimum charge of the daily pet fee PLUS \$500 for fumigation will be charged and you will be asked to vacate the premises immediately without refund.

**Emergency Calls:** For Fire, Ambulance or Police – Call 911. We have an excellent fire department right at the mountain that will provide first response.

**TV Remotes:** If you are having trouble getting the cable on your TV, please try pressing the input button on the remote (or on the TV) as it may simply be on the wrong input setting.

**Linens/Towels:** All linen and towels are provided. The beds have all been made, excluding the pull-out couch (if applicable to your unit). There are extra sheets provided for the pull out couch if you wish to use it. Please be advised that if you wish to change your sheets/towels during your stay, you can use the laundry machines in your unit or in the common room (if you are in a Creekside condo). Please be sure to bring your own laundry detergent.

**Garbage/ Recycling:** For stays 5 days or longer, your garbage/recycling will be picked up every three days. If your stay is a longer stay of 28 days or more, this will not apply; it will then be your responsibility to dispose of all garbage and recycling. You can take it to the transfer station which is just 2 minutes down the Silver Star Road. Heading down, once you pass the overhead skiway and pass The Ridge subdivision sign on your right, it is the next driveway on the right hand side.

**Cleaning:** We do not provide mid-stay cleans. However, if you would like to schedule the cleaning team to come in a clean your rental property during your stay, let us know and we can arrange this at your cost.

**Wi-Fi:** All our properties provide free wifi, if your wifi stops working, please unplug the modem - wait a couple of minutes and plug it again, this should fix the problem.

**Quiet Time:** Please respect your neighbours. Quiet time is before 7:00 a.m. and after 10:00 p.m.

**Check-out time is 10:00 a.m.**

**Check-in Time is 4:00 p.m.**

In order to give us time to do the laundry and prepare the property for the next visitors, we greatly appreciate you respecting this time schedule. Upon check-out, the unit will be thoroughly cleaned,

however we ask that you leave the kitchen clean and ALL dishes washed, or in the process of being washed in the dishwasher. If this has not been done you will incur a charge of \$50.00 plus tax.

If you do not vacate the property at the check-out time of 10:00 a.m. you will be charged **\$50.00 per hour** until you vacate the property and your personal items will be removed. This includes leaving your vehicle (for private townhomes/vacation properties) as the housekeepers need to have access at the 10:00 a.m. check out time.

**Late check-out or early check-in:**

Early check in or late check out may confirmed within 2 days prior to your arrival or departure but no later than one day prior to arrival or departure to arrange for housekeeping. Early check in rate applies from 8:00 a.m. on day of arrival and the late check out rate applies to 6:00 p.m. on day of departure

*The cost for early check in or late check out are as follows:*

Condos: \$85.00 (plus GST)

Townhomes: \$150.00 (plus GST)

Vacation Homes: \$250.00 (plus GST)

**Snow Clearing:** Please note this is a WINTER RESORT and that snow clearing is only done in the early mornings up at Silver Star if nightly snowfall exceeds 5 centimetres. If it has snowed all day, the roads and driveways may have snow accumulation. Please ensure that you come in a vehicle with winter tires (especially if you are renting a vehicle - insist on this as it is illegal to drive up here without snow tires).

If it has snowed overnight and your vehicle(s) are in the driveway, it will not be cleared. The machine operators do not get out of their vehicles, so if you would like your driveway cleared during your stay on the morning after a night snowfall, please move your vehicle to the public parking lot so that they can do so.

We also recommend that you carry booster cables with you as there is no service up here, so if your vehicle doesn't start, the only option is to call BCAA or another tow truck company in Vernon.

**Excess Parking:** If you have more vehicles than your rental unit can accommodate, please park the vehicles in the free overnight parking lot (Parking Lot A). Parking Lot A is located on Silver Lode Lane. If you take a slight left off of Silver Star Road onto Silver Lode Lane as you are coming into the village (just after the second bridge) you will see Parking Lot A on the right.

**Electric Vehicle Charging:** The Electric Vehicle Charging Station is in Parking Lot C Lot. It is located on the side of the green shed near the back end of this parking lot.

**Shoes & Boots:** It is a Canadian custom to remove your shoes and boots upon entry of any home. Please keep your boots and wet gear limited to the entryway.

**Rental Conditions:** We would like to thank you for choosing one of our properties for your holiday. Please treat this vacation property as you would your own, by leaving it in good condition.

As the occupants you are responsible for all damage or disappearance of items during your stay. Any damage will be charged to your credit card, which you have provided in lieu of a damage deposit. If the property you've rented is left in an excessively dirty condition you will be billed \$35.00 plus taxes per hour of additional cleaning (over the normal time spent for a clean).

For the comfort of our guests, all our properties are non-smoking (of any kind), including vaping - with the exception of outside or on the balcony. Please note Creekside is a non-smoking complex and some of the properties are non-smoking as well. Please do not litter - dispose of your cigarette butts properly.

Please note that if smoking (of any kind) or vaping occurs within the property that there will be a minimum of a \$500 fumigation fee. This is strictly enforced.

The following information is provided to help you plan your activities at Silver Star. Half the fun is in the anticipation.

**ATM Machine:** There is an ATM machine located within the Lord Aberdeen Market.

**Groceries:** There are major grocery stores within the city of Vernon. Just at the base of the Silver Star Road (in the Village Green Mall complex) is a Save On Foods (250-542-2968) [www.saveonfoods.com](http://www.saveonfoods.com) and also the very popular Butcher Boys (250-542-2968) which is on the way up the hill. This is a local grocery store (and liquor store) that has been expanded - offering great prices and variety. Both grocery stores will also deliver to Silver Star if requested (extra fees apply so that the groceries are there upon your arrival). Please provide them with our phone number 250-241-7827 to arrange a time.

*Butcher Boys* - you can either create an account, email or fax in your order (you cannot call in your order). Shopping fee is \$10.00 and delivery is \$30.00 plus gst for up to 4 boxes and \$1 per box thereafter. Please ask us for an order form or check out their website: [Butcher Boys](#)

*Save on Foods* - order online and either have it picked up or delivered. Delivery rates may vary (\$4.95+ depending on the day of the week). You can also order and pick up on your way up the mountain. Check out their website for more details: [Save on Foods](#)

In the Silver Star village, there is a convenience store called Lord Aberdeen market. You can pick up basic supplies here, plus it is also a liquor store. In addition, if you contact them directly 250-503-1992 they will do a major grocery shop for you and deliver it to your vacation home prior to your arrival.

**Catering/Private Dinners:** 1609 on the mountain is the place to call if you are looking for an at-home catering service or private chef. Please email Gemma ([gemma@1609.ca](mailto:gemma@1609.ca)) for any other information regarding your dinner or event but they do book up fast!

**On-Mountain Shuttle Bus:** Continual looped service throughout Silver Star Mountain Resort is available daily. You can catch the shuttle in the Village every half hour into the evening – so if you want to stop off for some après-ski, this free drive home is very convenient. You can also take this bus to the village. This service is available throughout Silver Star - the Knoll, the Ridge etc. Please note for the condo buildings the shuttle goes to the driveway entrance.

***Shuttles (to and from the Airport or other destinations):***

**Mojo Tours:** Be picked up in a Town and Country 4 person vehicle for **75.00** per person airport to Silver Star – Minimum of 2 people. Pick ups after 11pm at night have a **75.00** surcharge for trip.

They also have 2 large buses available for rental. One is a 12 passenger luxury coach and the other is a 20 passenger Ford E450. Each rent for **375.00** from the Airport to Silver Star. Grocery stops are **40.00** per hour. Gratuity is not included- if you are pleased with the service there is a recommendation of 10.00 per person. GST is not included in the above prices.

Prices listed are for a private vehicle with driver and are per vehicle. Prices include tax but do not include gratuity.

One person each way between YLW and Silverstar Mountain Resort is \$100.

Family/Group pricing between YLW and SilverStar Mountain Resort each way is \$100 plus \$30 per additional passenger.

Grocery shopping along the way can be added for an extra \$30. This includes a 1 hour stopover in Vernon to go to various places as you wish.

## **Snow Fun**

### **Ski Lift Tickets:**

You can purchase your ticket from the Village Ticket Office or at Brewer's Pond Base located at Tube Town. Tickets can be purchased in advance, so pop into one of the mentioned offices to grab your tickets.

**Save money by buying your ticket online!** You may purchase a discounted multi-day pass online before your arrival. Discounts are only available by booking online and must be purchased prior to your arrival.

For cross-country skiing and/or snowshoeing you can obtain your daily lift ticket either at Tube Town or at the main ticket booth in the Village, or as above, you can purchase the afternoon prior. If you wish to cross country ski at Sovereign Lake as well, just ask for the upgrade rate as we have reciprocal privileges.

**My-One Day Ticket:** When you purchase a daily downhill ski ticket you are able to tube, skate, cross country skiing or snowshoe and use the Fat-biking trails FREE.

**Insider Tip:** We also recommend for your tots that are under five, that you obtain a FREE My-One ticket for them even if they don't ski. This will allow them free access to all 5 included activities.

**Season's Pass.** If you plan on skiing more than 7 or 8 days, we recommend the purchase of a Season's Pass.

Other than a Season Pass, the best value for money is the **The POW Pass**. It can be purchased in the Fall and gives you approximately a 20 - 25% discount off 3 - 5 days of skiing (which does not need to be consecutive).

Please note - this option is available to Canadian & Washington state residents ONLY.

Each year, there may also be special promotions by local ski shops (Attridge, Olympic Sports, Source for Sports) that offer discounted daily tickets or Air Miles, etc.

**Tube Town/Adventure Park:** Tickets and rentals are available onsite. Enjoy outdoor skating and grab a hot chocolate and sit by the outdoor fire.

**Bowling Alley:** There is a modern, 10-pin bowling alley located on the ground floor of the Firelight building. It features a full bar, restaurant and bowling alleys. You may reserve for a bowling lane in advance, if desired. Very important during busy times. (The only ski in/ski out bowling alley in Canada!).

**Ski Waxing:** There is no waxing of skis within the units or on balconies. There is a complimentary wax room in the bottom floor of the N.A.T.C. building in the village plus for Creekside guests in SnowBrush.

**Ski Rentals and Repairs:** The Village Rental Shop is located in the centre of the Village, on the boardwalk. There is a new robotic machine called "The Monty" which does all your edges, bases and waxing. All the necessities for winter fun can be rented, including Cross Country, Downhill Skis and Snowboards. Cross Country equipment including Telemark and Snowshoes are also available at The Village Ski Shop in the Village. Ice Skate rentals are available at Tube Town. If you're looking to buy new gear, check out Evolve in the village.

**Ski School:** Silver Star SnowSports School instructors are some of the most experienced in Canada. Lessons are available daily – either in the morning or the afternoon. Call 250-558-6065 for more information. They offer a fabulous kids program as well; including day-care and daycare/ski programs.

**Free Guided Mountain Tours:** New to the mountain, or simply want some company to show you around the mountain? Our friendly volunteer group of ski partners are on hand daily to provide you with a free guided tour of the mountain. This is offered for cross-country and downhill skiers and boarders. Tours depart at 9:30am daily from outside the Resort Information board located in front of the Town Hall. Skiers and boarders should be at least an intermediate level to participate on the blue runs.

**Fat Biking:** Fat Biking is included in your “My-One Pass” list of activities; there are more than 15 km of fat bike trails open for riders and a fleet of rental bikes available. Rentals are available in the village, if you would like to give this sport a try.
